



What is a PBX?

- A PBX is a central server to which all phones connect. This server enables any phone to call any other phone on that server.
- It also has other features
 - Conferencing
 - Voice Mail
 - Trunking
- Trunking is a feature where a phone on one PBX can call another phone on a different PBX
